










The University of Guelph-Humber.

- Located in Toronto where there is significant growth in demand for post-secondary places and employer demand.

- Integrated curriculum means graduates earn both an Undergraduate honours degree and an applied Diploma.






- Programs started in 2002 partly as a response to the ‘double cohort’ and currently there are 2,600 students in 8 programs.
- Programs feature small classes and work experience, placement or practicum.
- Graduates go on to teacher’s college, law school, graduate programs, and employment in Canada and internationally.



The Kinesiology Program

- The University of Guelph-Humber is a joint venture, not an independent institution.
 - **Is responsible to both Boards of Governors, but with separate financial statements.**
 - Vice-provost is the CEO and Chief Academic Officer reporting through joint Executive, and Finance & Administration committees.

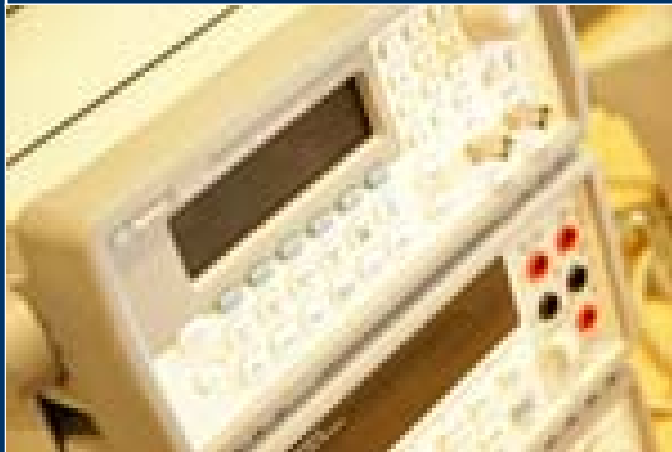

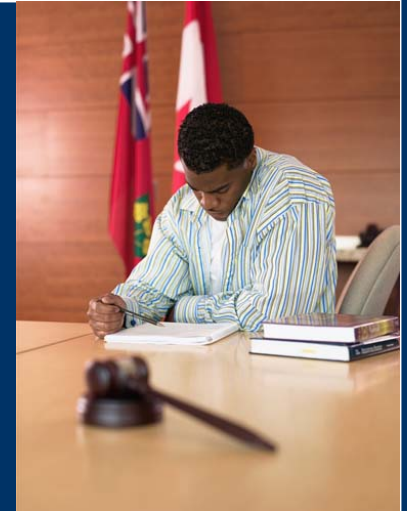
