

Pan-Canadian Organization Sub-Committee

At the June 21-23 2010 Pan-Canadian Consortium on Admissions and Transfer (PCCAT) Annual General Meeting (AGM) a discussion paper, the *PCCAT Future Organizational/Operational Model "Thoughts" for Discussion* was presented for the consortiums consideration and feedback. This paper, drafted by Ron Woodward, Western Co-Chair of PCCAT addressed the structure and status of PCCAT as an organization. In addition, it posed questions about where the members wanted the consortium to head and how it would like the body to be formalized. The paper was drafted, in part, as the result of the challenges and limitations the consortium's lack of formal structure creates for the administration of the annual event.

The 2010 discussion led to the formation of the PCCAT Organization Sub-committee which was tasked with reviewing the purpose of PCCAT and developing recommendations for the consortium to formalize its structure. Robin Fisher, Mount Royal University, agreed to Chair the sub-committee. The *PCCAT Terms of Reference* was developed by the sub-committee over the past year, which includes "*Next Steps*" for the organization going forward.
